How Do You Feel About Garbage Disposals?

Claims that kitchen waste doesn't impact septic tank treatment remind me of the promise that wet wipes are "flushable"

re garbage disposals the same as flushable wipes when it comes to deceptive marketing? I'm asking this question after an article promoting the use of garbage disposals with septic systems crossed my desktop recently.

The story reminded me of the wipes manufacturers promising their convenient products are "flushable" but leaving out one important fact: Sure, you can flush them down the toilet, but what happens when the wipes build up in the household plumbing or make their way to the septic tank? All of us know the answer to that — and the disastrous consequences.

Like the universal advice from pumpers and other septic system experts to avoid so-called "flushable" wipes, industry experts have been pretty clear on the question of adding a garbage disposal in houses using septic systems. Let's review the succinct recommendation on the topic from our friends at the Water Resources Center at the University of Minnesota Onsite Sewage Treatment Program. Its website states:

"Do not use a garbage disposal or dispose of vegetables, meat, fat, oil, coffee grounds, and other undigested food products in the septic system. Use composting or garbage service."

Often the message I hear from pumpers is even shorter, if not sweeter: The only things you should flush down the toilet are what comes out of your body and toilet paper.

HEY, IT'S OK

So my eyebrows were raised when an article came to me from the blackbirdnews.com touting the use of an unnamed garbage disposal designed for septic system users. It actually said a garbage disposal offers septic users distinct advantages over simply throwing food waste away.

It stated the undersink grinder "reduces the quantity of food waste that is added to the tank. Instead of throwing away food scraps in the trash, which can quickly accumulate and cause odors, homeowners can grind up their food waste and send it down the drain."

Using this — again unnamed — garbage disposal, breaks down the food waste, reducing the risk of clogs and backups: "When food scraps are ground up and sent down the drain, they are exposed to more surface area, which allows bacteria and other microorganisms to break them down more efficiently. This means that food waste is processed more quickly in the septic tank."

My eyebrows were raised when an article came to me ... touting the use of an unnamed garbage disposal designed for septic system users. It actually said a garbage disposal offers septic users distinct advantages over simply throwing food waste away.

Then the most dubious statement of all: "(A) garbage disposal for septic tanks can also help to reduce the need for septic tank pumping. When too much waste accumulates in the tank, it can become full and require pumping to remove the excess. However, by using a garbage disposal to grind up food waste, homeowners can help to keep the tank from filling up too quickly."

I call fake news.

I told you earlier that the article didn't name the septic-safe garbage disposal. But it did include a hyperlink that takes the reader to the website of the InSinkErator company, the largest manufacturer of garbage disposals — where you are greeted by this message:

TRUTH ABOUT GARBAGE DISPOSALS

"You've probably been told that using a garbage disposal to get rid of food waste is going to upset that delicate [septic] system. The reality is, it won't." Then the company reveals what it calls "the truth about garbage disposals" for septic systems. And it's a real doozy:

"A garbage disposal grinds food waste to easily flow through a home's plumbing and into a septic tank. Once there, food scraps decompose faster than other waste sent into the tank. Because food scraps are 75% to 90% water, they add very little to the solids that settle at the bottom of the tank. Studies show that septic systems attached to a garbage disposal don't require more frequent pumping than those that aren't."

This statement directly contradicts every message I have heard from the top septic system experts and educators over the past 20 years, as well as the experience of pumpers in the field. It's another way this reminds me of the

"flushable" wipe messaging from those who want to sell consumers wet wipes.

InSinkErator is now selling a garbage disposal, the Evolution Septic Assist, it says is specifically created for use with septic systems. The unit injects what it calls exclusive "Bio-Charge" enzyme treatment when in use, which it claims helps keep septic systems running smoothly. I would be interested to hear if pumpers have any anecdotal experience with this garbage disposal. Please share your stories at editor@pumper.com and I will include them in a future article here.

Whether or to what degree the new disposal reduces the negative impact of added food wastes on septic systems is unclear to me. But I suspect pumpers and our industry experts would say that not using any garbage disposal in the first place remains the better option.

LISTEN TO THE PROS

I will take the word of professionals who maintain septic systems over the company trying to sell garbage disposals. Consider *Pumper's* longtime friends at Tim Frank Septic Tank Cleaning in Ohio — first Tim, and his son Tom Frank, wife Carol and the family. They are past presidents and members of the National Association of Wastewater Technicians, certified septic system inspectors, and qualified service providers of the Ohio Waste Haulers Association. Here's what they say in their website blog on caring for septic systems:

"Most garbage disposal manufacturers are quick to tell you that yes, you can use their product with your septic system, but ignore the ugly truth that can be hiding behind that answer. It is not OK. You really shouldn't be using a garbage disposal with your septic system."

The Franks go on to explain that using a garbage disposal overloads the human wastes accumulating in the septic tank. "This excess waste will never get a chance to break down in the wet environment," the Franks go on. "The thing that garbage disposal manufacturers don't tell you is that you have to pump your tank at least twice as often if you use their product."


The message the Franks share with consumers is a valuable one. Adding a garbage disposal makes a septic system work harder. It may increase the chance of system failure without more diligent maintenance, and extra pumping over time raises the price for what should be a very efficient and cost-effective treatment system.

PROCEED WISELY

Following the advice of pumping industry leaders, it would seem to make sense for your customers to avoid installing garbage disposals. And experts will say that if a homeowner on septic already has a garbage disposal, use it sparingly and dispose of most kitchen waste in a compost pile, the garbage bin or feed it to the chickens in the backyard.

So, are the companies that market garbage disposals as septic-safe providing disinformation similar to those who promote using "flushable" wipes? You tell me. What has been your experience with garbage disposals and septic system users? Does the general public understand the proper use and limitations of these machines? Or as with the wipes, are they oblivious to the harm these products might be doing to their septic systems?

The Employee Retention Tax Credit program may be inactive, but it remains a vital way for businesses to recoup COVID-era losses, and to reward themselves for maintaining their workforce throughout an uncertain season. If you believe that your business is eligible to claim this tax credit retroactively, you'll want to file an amended tax return.

TIM HACK

yle Hack never wanted to leave Tidy Tim's Inc., the company his parents, Tim and Patty Hack, founded in 1995 as a side business after purchasing 28 restrooms and a service truck from a portable restroom operator. Kyle's sister, Katie Gossett, never intended to stay with the business.

But both came back several years ago and are transitioning in as shareholders in the incorporated business with their spouses. It's a much bigger business than it was 28 years ago, with the addition of septic tank pumping, installation, repair and inspection services and more employees to deal with the growing demand in central Ohio.

One thing that hasn't changed is the Hacks' values and priorities to grow a successful business. But so much has changed in the business structure, size, equipment inventory and marketing during the transition — and since *Pumper* featured Tidy Tim's a mere seven years ago.

TOGETHER AGAIN

Kyle grew up in the business and drove a vacuum truck as soon as he got his driver's license. He was eager to continue working for Tidy Tim's, but after he graduated from high school in 2013, his parents insisted he go to college, where he earned an associate degree in livestock management.

"I could have used his help," Tim says, admitting he regretted never

going to college. "I just wanted Kyle to have that experience — and a backup plan."

"We had mixed feelings about sending him away [to college]," Patty agrees. "We were anxious for him to get through that and start helping us. Tim and I were to a point where we couldn't grow without help and we weren't comfortable hiring people."

Going to college and working a short time for a dairy farmer made Kyle aware of other options and even more sure that he wanted to work for the family business.

"It was a great experience and I met my wife there," Kyle

says about college. But he never stopped working at Tidy Tim's, helping on weekends and summers, until he joined full time in 2017.

Meanwhile, his older sister, Katie, loved her job in agricultural communications for a cattle rancher's association.

"I loved being out talking to people, writing and doing design work," she says. But when she and her husband Zach had their first child, the 40-minute commute and workday left little time for her at home.

Patty was doing daycare for her grandson and one evening Tim halfjoked that Katie should work for Tidy Tim's. The next day Katie decided it could be a good option.

"Katie was unexpected," Patty says, but she and Tim were happy when she joined them in 2016.

"They both brought new ideas."

ESTABLISHING ROLES

"When Katie came on board, we still had the phone ringing into our home and were answering the phone until 8 at night," Tim recalls. "When they both came on, we were just so busy, we just hit the ground running."

Katie took over answering phones and started performing tasks that led to her role as office manager.

Tim and Patty were grateful for the help. They'd held back from too much expansion to maintain the service and quality cleaning standards they set for the business. Kyle and Katie shared their work ethic and pride in offering good service.

Like any family that works together they all recognize the importance and challenge of communicating with each other and working out differences.

"Mom is the glue of it all," Kyle says.

Patty is a natural mediator, so whenever something goes wrong or there is conflict, she is the first person her children talk to. She listens and helps them think the issue through, and they often conclude that it wasn't as serious as they thought.

In addition to that role and being the primary child care provider for Katie's three sons, Patty handles accounts payable and is an integral part of the business from her home office.

Katie takes care of marketing, invoices and manages office staff. Julie Logan works on the septic side with scheduling and inspections. Chelsey Hack, Kyle's wife, deals with the portable restroom side of the business, which is Kyle's niche. He drives a service truck and oversees the other drivers.

Katie's husband, Zach, oversees scheduling for septic pumping and installs, as well as inspects systems.

"I do whatever Katie tells me to do," Tim teases. "As owner my role is to oversee everything but I don't need to micromanage, and they come to me with the tougher questions and decisions which I appreciate. I love being in my truck, I love to talk to people and meet with the new install customers. I handle the permitting, and deal with the tank provider and materials for installs.

"I like that we are getting to a point where our roles are more defined," he adds. "We are trying to put ourselves in a position to have more of a life outside of work."

As with any business with multiple owners, there are differences of opinions.

"We have an open line of communication and talk about issues right away so they don't fester," Katie says, adding that Tim has been open to their ideas.

EMPLOYEES ON THE TEAM

Having a core of dependable employees makes success possible. Though there was some turnover with staff last year, Katie emphasizes how much they appreciate the people that make the Tidy Tim's team.

www.tuff-jon.com Ad on page 21 Several employees have been with Tidy Tim's for nearly five years, including Jon Franklin who helps out on the septic side with pumping, repairs and installations. Derek Barker runs a restroom route, trains new route drivers and does quality control on other drivers' routes. Tim Brake also plays a vital role and works on both the portable restroom and the septic side, doing weekend deliveries and pickups as well as septic inspections. Steve Shipley oversees cleaning and repairs of portable restrooms and handles shop maintenance.

The Hacks have adapted new strategies for hiring, starting with the interview process.

"We ask them to ride with one of the guys as part of the interview and we pay them for the day," Kyle says. "So, they [applicants] understand what we do."

Once hired, the Hacks follow up with lots of on-the-job training, and all employees gather for monthly meetings, plus additional meetings in the summer. To keep good workers, sometimes the Hacks transition employees between the septic and portable restroom side of the business to better match the worker's needs and skills.

Tidy Tim's offers benefits that include health insurance and retirement. Plus, workers receive quarterly bonuses if they don't make any major mistakes. That goes for owners as well, Tim says, noting he's had to dock himself a time or two.

EXPANDED FLEET

With more employees, more equipment is needed. Tidy Tim's recently purchased a new septic service truck, a 2023 Kenworth with a 4,500-gallon stainless steel tank, a National Vacuum Equipment blower and hose reel built by Pik Rite. It's the largest tank they've ever had.

"Because of the growth of business on the septic side, the big truck will help us be more efficient to haul two or three pumped tanks with one shot," Tim says.

Initially, the plan was to have the new truck replace a present rig, but because of demand, Tidy Tim's will likely keep both of the older trucks — a 2005 Kenworth

with a 2,300-gallon steel tank with an NVE pump and jetter built by Transport Truck Sales, Kansas City, Kansas; and a 1993 Mack with a 3,500-gallon steel tank and a Moro pump built by Elliot Machine Works in nearby Galion, Ohio.

Other equipment for the septic side of the business includes a 2003 Dodge Ram service truck, two John Deere excavators (35C and 50) and a John Deere 325 skid-steer, a Superior Signal Smoke Tool, two MyTana cameras, a MyTana locator and a Milwaukee drain cleaning machine.

For the portable restroom part of the business, Tidy Tim's has seven trucks. The newest is a 2023 Ford F-550 with an 800-gallon waste/400-gallon freshwater stainless steel tank with an NVE 304 pump built by Best Enterprises. Best Enterprises also built three other trucks with the same pump: a 2018 Dodge Ram 4500 with a 650-gallon waste/250-gallon freshwater steel tank; and two Kenworth trucks (2017 and 2005) with 1,100-gallon waste/400-gallon freshwater stainless steel tanks. The other trucks are a homebuilt 2014 Isuzu with a 700-gallon waste/300-gallon freshwater poly saddle tank and NVE 304 pump; a 2014 Dodge Ram 5500 with a 950-gallon waste/300-gallon freshwater aluminum tank and Masport pump, built by FlowMark; and a 2005 Ford with an 800-gallon waste/300-gallon freshwater steel tank and Masport pump built by Crescent Tank Mfg.

Tidy Tim's has 745 portable restrooms including Satellite special event and construction models and T.S.F. construction units. Their six restroom trailers come from Satellite Suites, JAG Mobile Solutions, NuConcepts and a self-built nonflushing unit. F.M. Manufacturing built a 16-unit hauler and another 10-unit trailer was built in-house.

To accommodate the growth, Tidy Tim's recently moved from its twobay shop and office trailer into a new 7,000-square-foot shop with five offices, a large breakroom and enough room to house most of their trucks.

TRANSITIONAL CHANGES

Tidy Tim's marketing has changed with Katie's communication skills. She uses social media and works with a website company to continually make changes. "Based on calls and website queries, it's doing well," she says.

The business also uses radio advertising, which reaches throughout Tidy Tim's expanded coverage area and includes a growing population and new homes north of Columbus, resulting in install inquiries. Additional work



Spouses come aboard

Zach Gossett was the first of the younger generation to start working full time for Tidy Tim's. He met his wife Katie at Ohio State University and worked in agronomy sales. In 2015, when Ohio adopted new operation and maintenance regulations for septic systems, his father-in-law Tim Hack wanted to expand services.

"Tim brought me on to be the septic inspector. It was a similar role dealing with people, but instead of selling I was providing a service," Gossett says. "I rode with Tim to learn it and he trained me on everything. As my knowledge grew my roles have changed."

Gossett now shares inspection work with another employee so he can also install systems. And, with a CDL, he pumps tanks when needed. He's been part of the growth of the septic side of the business at Tidy Tim's. Part of that is from his seat on the Ohio Onsite Wastewater Association board, where he learns about new ideas and products.

"I am very efficiency-based — how we can do things better, faster, cheaper. Also, growth focused, of seeing potential customer growth and how to set us up for success in the next year and five to 10 years," Gossett says.

He says that he and Tim don't always agree about ways to do things. But they have a good relationship and respect for each other's opinions.

Becoming part of the family business has been the right choice, Gossett says. "I enjoy being outside and helping customers solve problem and just explaining how a system works. The customer interaction is what drives me the most," he explains.

EASING INTO ROLE

Like Zach, Chelsey Hack met her spouse at college. She knew what she was getting into when she married Kyle Hack. Many of their "dates" between college classes included riding with Kyle to service restrooms. After graduating with a degree in natural resources management and working as a metro park ranger, she continued to help Kyle on second shifts and weekends. In 2019 she started working full time for Tidy Tim's.

"I started from the bottom, washing toilets," she says. And she rode with two different portable restroom route drivers for nearly two years. "Doing a route got me comfortable running all the trucks and then adding the trailer I started hauling and picking up restrooms [for weekend events]."

That experience is useful now that she helps manage the portable restroom side of the business. She schedules 14 service routes a week with Smart Service software that works with QuickBooks and links to drivers' iPads with directions and detailed instructions. Knowing how driving routes work, she can relate to the drivers and troubleshoot problems when customers call.

And, reminiscent of their courtship, she and Kyle often work together transporting restrooms on busy weekends.

"I love the family and we get along great, but there are some growing pains with transitions. We make so many decisions together, which is nice sometimes because we have different perspectives," Chelsey says.

comes from two businesses Tidy Tim's bought out and response from reminder cards sent out to past septic customers.

Change has come frequently and often since the first *Pumper* profile on Tidy Tim's in 2017. It now has two septic truck routes every day covering a 13-county area. Portable

is still the biggest part of the operation at about 60% of the work. Septic pumping and installation accounts for about 30% with 10% for inspection work.

Tidy Tim's is incorporated and the transition from Tim and Patty's ownership is gradual as their children earn stock in the business. The parents will keep stock in the business for income in their retirement. Everyone is open to growth and new opportunities.

"I'm not ready to take my foot off the gas as long as we don't lose quality," Tim says.

With Intel and distribution center building projects attracting thousands

of people and a housing boom in the region, there will be more installations and service calls. New Ohio regulations require septic maintenance such as switching elbows in distribution boxes and cleaning effluent filters. Plus, there are more mechanical aeration and spray irrigation systems that require annual inspections.

There's also more demand for portable restrooms and Kyle stays proactive, taking turns running routes to maintain quality control and watching for opportunities where to grow that side of the business.

THE ROAD AHEAD

As Tidy Tim's works through transitioning from one generation to the next, the talents of each family member are important. And so is their unified focus.

"You won't find young people that work harder than they do, and with integrity," Tim says about his children and their spouses. "And we are all good at organizing, looking ahead, anticipating. Then it takes just one phone call and there's the stuff you don't plan for and you have to roll with it."

"Twenty-eight years ago, Tim and I never thought this is where we were going to be," Patty adds. "We are happy that we can provide a service to this community. We try to be active and give back."

And that same spirit drives Kyle, Katie and their spouses as they take over Tidy Tim's and an even larger coverage area. **P**

Have You Considered Sponsoring a Local Event to Boost Exposure?

You can tap into the lessons Toyota has learned sponsoring NASCAR and use them on a much smaller scale for your wastewater business

oping to gain exposure, build goodwill and connect with a specific audience? (What small business isn't?) Sponsoring a local event might be a great option.

But not an easy option. While every event provides some sort of experience, the key is to partner with an event that provides an experience people will associate positively with your brand — and hopefully further characterizes and adds depth to your brand.

Then you need to leverage that experience, which requires more than simply slapping your logo onto a banner (even though that kind of awareness marketing does make an impact). You need to engage participants. Provide perks. Provide discounts. Integrate your sponsorship with the event's promotions. Align your sponsorship with the event's goals, and vice versa.

Yep: Not so easy — but when done well, extremely effective.

So where should you start? Don't try to reinvent the wheel. Take a few pages from an already successful playbook.

Perfect example (though decidedly not on the smaller scale of a septic service or portable sanitation company): The Toyota Owners 400 at Richmond Raceway. Toyota has been the title sponsor for the spring NASCAR race at Richmond for more than a decade. Toyota also sponsors the Camping World Truck Series event; as Richmond Raceway President Dennis Bickmeier says, "They take over the track for the weekend."

While sponsoring the race does generate plenty of visibility — the Toyota branding, while tasteful, is basically ubiquitous — lesson one is that for Toyota, the partnership is part of a long-term customer engagement strategy.

FIND YOUR FANS

"When Toyota first got involved in NASCAR," says Paul Doleshal, general manager of motorsports and assets for Toyota North America, "the average NASCAR fan didn't consider buying a Toyota. Purchase consideration, much less purchase intent, was extremely low."

For Toyota, entering the NASCAR world enabled the company to interact with fans in their comfort zone, and use that opportunity to learn about consumer tastes and interests. And to organically become part of the conversation.

"Data shows that while at first you might get a boost from being the shiny new toy," Doleshal says, "What matters more is the authenticity you bring to the sport — and the longevity that shows you're there to make it better: To enhance their weekend. To improve their experience. To show your appreciation. Only then will people pay attention to your message. If you're not there, first and

foremost, to serve the consumer, ... then you shouldn't be there."

That leads to lesson two: Consider using event sponsorship as a reward for current customers, not just as a sales tool.

Over the years Toyota has provided owners — the race is the Toyota Owners 400, after all — with a number of perks. Special entrances for any fan with a Toyota, Lexus or Scion key fob. Private events at the track. Special viewing areas. Tailgate events. Track rides. Free race tickets. Not as a direct incentive for becoming a new customer, but as a "thank you" for being an existing customer.

"It's definitely not just advertising," says Tanner Hulette, vice president of Page Auto Group and president of the Central Atlantic Toyota Dealers Association. "It's more about rewarding Toyota ownership. The five dealers supporting the race get bulk tickets, suite passes, get to choose people from their owner bases to put in the spotlight ... the celebration of ownership is great for the dealerships."

For local dealers, the event sponsorship creates a meaningful way to engage long-term customers. Instead of simply sending postcards or emails to hopefully stay top of mind, the race creates a natural touch point. A natural conversation starter. An organic way to get customers back into the dealership and reinforce the relationship.

Those relationships have paid off. "Brand recognition for our market is exceptional coming out of the race," Hulette says.

Which leads to lesson three. Building long-term customer relationships pays off in increased lifetime customer value, but it also helps generate new customers. Word of mouth matters. Referrals matter. Giving your customers unprompted, organic reasons to talk about their experiences with your brand matters.



But that's only if you pay attention to lesson four: See the event as a true partner, not just the vehicle for a marketing effort.

CHOOSE THE RIGHT EVENT

"This is where the sport — teams, drivers, sponsors, fans — comes together," Bickmeier says. "We want people who come to the track to have the best experience they possibly can. So we provide the access, the exposure, the midway, the ride and drive opportunities ... anything we can help Toyota do to improve the experience for their customers is a win for us, since it enhances the experience for our customers, too."

And that's lesson five: Pick an event that sees you as a partner, not just a business writing a check. And one that is willing to build the relationship over time.

Toyota's success at Richmond Raceway isn't unusual; Federated Auto Parts has been the title sponsor for the fall Richmond Race since 2012.


"A long-term partnership shouldn't be rinse and repeat," Bickmeier says. "Find new ways to reward your customers. Find new ways to engage with them. Find new ways to collect data, collect information, create new touch points ... make sure the event is willing to grow and evolve with you."

And that's the final lesson: Make sure you know what you receive for your investment.

Different events offer different levels of sponsorship. Know exactly what you will receive. If you're looking for exclusivity, either as a title sponsor or as the only sponsor from your particular industry, make sure you will get it.

GET YOUR NAME OUT THERE

Event sponsorship can be a great marketing, brand awareness, and brand building tool. But it's also an investment — so make sure you know what you will get for your investment.









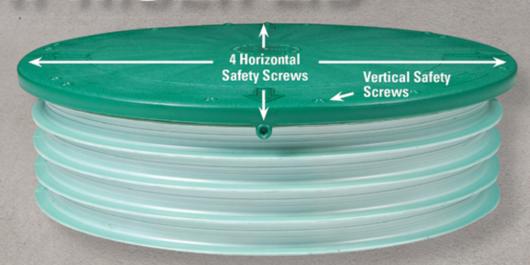

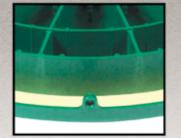

Is It Time to Eliminate **Toilet Paper From** Septic Systems?

Many countries ban bathroom tissue in the septic tank and utilize the bidet as an alternative to wiping

ast winter, I traveled to see a good friend in Mexico. His Pacific coastal village of Trancones, Guerrero, has around 500 year-round residences that rely upon septic systems to treat wastewater. I was there to discuss how homeowners can improve their septic systems and plan for the future. One question came up several times during this trip: "Is it OK to flush my toilet paper?"

Honestly, having lived in the U.S. my entire life I had not really thought much about this issue. I have noticed on my travels to Europe that the use of bidets is common. And during the pandemic — when there was a shortage of toilet paper — more and more American began re-evaluating their hygiene regimen.

A map made by Matt Kitson of mindofahitchhiker.com shows how much of the world (red colors) forbids toilet paper from being flushed. This clearly shows that a majority of the world either does not use toilet paper or does not flush toilet paper, which makes you wonder how flushing toilet

paper impacts our septic systems and if we should consider other options. We all know that with small or damaged sewer lines, low-flow toilets, excessive toilet paper can cause blocked lines and plugged effluent baffles. But does it impact the need for pumping or what we are sending out to our advanced pretreatment or soil treatment areas?

All these questions lead to a small lab study at the University of Minnesota where we studied how toilet paper breaks down, and then measured how the tissue impacts typical wastewater parameters. In this study we tested three traditional papers (Scott Comfort, Scott Professional, Pacific Blue) and one bamboo product (Caboo). Traditional toilet paper is derived from tree pulp while bamboo is the largest member of the grass family.

We added seven squares (av-

It is likely in most wastewater treatment plants and septic systems that the toilet paper is settling out into the sludge layer. A 2019 article analyzing sewage sludge from wastewater treatment plants showed an average of 87% cellulose fibers. Toilet paper is contributing to the sludge production in our septic tanks.

Our next question was: Does toilet paper add to the waste strength? To determine the impact, we took samples from the middle layer to avoid solids that had settled. Analysis of the total suspended solids and biochemical oxygen demand were performed. Nitrogen and phosphorus were measured too, but the data are not shown as all results were less than 2 mg/L.

After we saw these results, we wondered how toilet paper would settle and break down in septic tank effluent, so we ran the study again mixing the toilet paper with effluent from a septic tank and analyzed samples after three days. The table compares the various toilet paper brands to regular septic tank effluent.

From the data with water after 30 minutes and three days, Caboo bamboo does have significantly higher levels of TSS, indicating more of the toilet paper was in suspension and not settling the same way as the other brands were. The Pacific Blue has higher BOD levels than the rest at 30 minutes, but this changed after three days, where the Caboo was the highest followed by Scott Comfort, Scott Pro and Pacific Blue.

The results with septic tank effluent show the difference is not as significant, with Caboo being the only one significantly higher in TSS and BOD values. This data in general indicates toilet paper is not adding a considerable treatment load to downstream components, but producing more sludge in the system as it is settling out in septic tank. Homes or businesses that use a lot of toilet paper may need more frequent tank cleaning.

INSTALLING BIDETS

Bidets are a French invention that are common in western Europe and grew in popularity in the 1980s in Japan and South Korea when the toilet and bidet were combined into one unit, which also dries and sometimes even has a seat warmer. In the U.S. and Canada there has been an increase in bidet usage since the toilet paper shortage due to the recent pandemic.



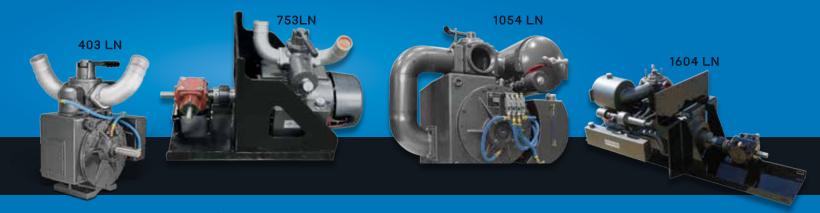
There are other reasons why people may consider installing a bidet, including feeling cleaner, health and hygiene benefits and choosing the eco-friendliest option. The only concern with bidets is the potential increase in water usage in arid climates where water shortages are stressing water supplies. If you have a customer who installs a bidet, their need for septic tank pumping may decrease due to decreased sludge production.

The use or amount of toilet paper used in a home or business can cause plumbing and baffle problems. Toilet paper does contribute to sludge production, so facilities with high usage of toilet paper may need tanks cleaned more often than homes with bidets or very low toilet paper usage. In either case, the effluent parameters with and without toilet paper are very similar.

Based on this work, what should my friends in Mexico do?

There are two challenges in Mexico related to this topic — the first is that many septic tanks are smaller than those in the U.S. and the second is proper disposal of septage is often not done and when it is done correctly it is expensive. Therefore being conservative in the amount of toilet paper you use, not flushing the toilet paper, or using a bidet are all good options to reduce the frequency of tank pumping. **P**





Spreading the Word About Septic System Maintenance

Three counties in New York's Lake Erie region band together to promote pumping and onsite inspections

n the eastern end of Lake Erie three counties have combined to improve water quality by educating people about septic systems.

Work began with a website (erie.gov/septicsmart/) to collect in one place information about how septic systems work and how to maintain them.

"We've realized in conversation that a lot of folks don't necessarily know how their septic system works, or don't pay attention to it, and don't know that it needs maintenance," says Joanna Panasiewicz, coordinator for the Lake Erie Watershed Protection Alliance. The alliance is a combined effort of Erie, Cattaraugus, and Chautauqua counties, and outreach is funded for one year by a community grant from the New York State Pollution Prevention Institute.

The website makes two points for people, she notes: First, proper system maintenance can save money for homeowners by reducing the need for costly replacements, and second, proper maintenance can help improve water quality in the lake.

HEAD OFF ALGAE BLOOMS

The alliance was formed in 2009 in response to flooding, Panasiewicz says. The counties realized looking at a broad area beyond their borders was necessary to address some problems.

Septic education work began not in response to problems but in the hope of avoiding them. There haven't been any algae blooms on the eastern end of the lake, Panasiewicz says, "but some inland lakes in New York State, have been experiencing harmful algal bloom issues. So it's not quite here yet, but we know there's potential."

Last year the U.S. Geological Survey released a study of phosphorus contributed to the Great Lakes by selected tributary rivers. The Maumee River in Ohio, which flows through Toledo on the western end of the lake, contributed the greatest volume. That's because its watershed is very large, she says. In terms of flow-weighted mean concentration (measured as total phosphorus per square kilometer of drainage area), the most polluting stream was Cattaraugus Creek, which borders Chautauqua, Cattaraugus and Erie counties and flows into the lake.

Septic tanks are one potential source of that pollutant, Panasiewicz says. The Erie County Health Department estimates there are 47,000 septic systems in Erie County alone.


"We're developing a watershed management plan for the Lake Erie and Niagara River watershed here in western New York State, and so we're trying to look at what are all those potential sources of contamination and how do we address those," she says.

Erie County borders the lake and includes the city of Buffalo. Chautauqua County is immediately south on the shore, and Cattaraugus County is inland but is part of the Lake Erie watershed.

PUMPING REBATES

"On top of creating that website, we're also doing workshops. Because of COVID we weren't sure exactly how it was going to go, so we've been doing a mix of virtual and in-person," she says. The webinar was recorded and is available on the alliance website.

When the alliance contacted pumpers about the workshops, she says, some of them offered door prizes. One pumper who services only aerobic systems, which are not common in the area, offered a free inspection, she says. Everyone who attends a workshop and has a pumpout following it receives a \$30 rebate, she says. "So the hope is this incentivizes acting upon

what they've learned in these workshops."

The county has an ordinance requiring an onsite system inspection at the time of sale, Panasiewicz says. There are about 1,500 sales annually, yet the rule doesn't always work.

"A lot of these older homes, they may pass to a family member and not go through a property transfer. That's where there may not be any inspections on record, and that's a concern for us," Panasiewicz says. Older properties, especially seasonal cottages, may not receive necessary maintenance, she adds, and the pandemic meant some people schooled their children at home and worked from home, and used their septic systems much more than usual.

There is hope that the outreach program will continue after the grant expires. Education and the website will continue, and perhaps the counties will be able to hold an annual septic system workshop, she says.

Panasiewicz has a degree in biology and has been working on water quality issues in Erie County for about 12 of her 14 years there. Before her water quality work she dealt with pollution prevention for businesses and hotels, which included looking at energy use and controlling waste.

"This project is a good example of how government and business can work together with similar goals," Panasiewicz says. "Pumpers are obviously looking to increase their business, and this is an example of where that service is important for water quality."

Portable restroom and roll-off business adapts to new software

Problem: When Containers Inc. in Pensacola, Florida, was acquired through a merger, they inherited web-based

Using QR codes for dumpster pickup and swap services


Problem: Bindrop Waste Services serves the roll-off trash container needs for commercial and residential customers in the New Jersey area. The company uses online shopping cart software for new container rentals. When the containers are onsite, standard pickup or swap requests are made over the phone or by email. The support team often has to follow up with the customer to confirm details, such as location or consent to charge on the account. This takes time and occupies phone lines from taking new orders.

Solution: The company used QR code technology from AirVote to optimize the process of sending standard service requests from container locations. Each unit has two associated QR codes displayed on a large decal placed on the container: one for pickups and the other for swaps. When onsite customers scan the QR code, the system prefills the request with the available information from the customer's device, such as the name, phone number, and GPS location. The customer fills in the required information and can send additional notes and pictures. The completed request is sent to the company along with the associated unit ID.

Result: The support team gets needed information to service the customer. It saves time and keeps the lines open for sales. Additionally, QR codes displayed on site are a visual reminder for customers to request swap/pickup service. Name and title or job description: Darrell MacKenzie, president and general manager

Business name and location: MacKenzie Environmental, Alma, Nova Scotia, Canada.

Services we offer: Septic tank pumping, portable sanitation, hydroexcavation, industrial and commercial pumping, high-pressure washing, dust control for roads and bulk water hauling.

Age: 56

Years in the industry: My grandfather James Robert MacKenzie formed the company in 1964. I started traveling with him when I was about five or six years old and I've been doing it ever since. My father Charles Robert MacKenzie took over from him and then I took over in 1993.

Association involvement: I've been with Waste Water Nova Scotia since 2006. I've been on the board of directors since 2006 and serve as one of two provincial representatives for pumpers, portable restroom operators and cleaners.

Benefits of belonging to the association: The association helps keep everybody on the same page and keeps the training up to snuff, which also helps protect customers. And, importantly, we work really well with the government. There's been great cooperation and it's very easy to get stuff done. We have our differences, of course, but it's worked out and there are never any major issues.

Biggest issue facing your association right now: Because of the real estate boom here during COVID, when people were moving out of the cities and working remotely, anyone could go out and buy a push camera and do septic system inspections with no training or qualifications. That situation is at the forefront of what the association is concerned with right now. WWNS is trying to come up with some guidelines for people practicing this type of work. Our hope is to eventually have the government regulate the inspections.

Our crew includes: We have administrative manager Tanya Smith, administrative assistant Karen Marshall, accounts receivable and payable manager Doreen Rector, and operators Travis MacKenzie (my son), Shawn MacKenzie (my brother), D.J. Worth and Blake Kontuck.

Typical day on the job: I'm usually in the office by 4:30 or 5 a.m. I catch up on paperwork and get things organized for the day. I do all the bidding for the contracts and tenders. I look at jobs, perform maintenance on vehicles, and even get in the truck and go do the work myself if we're busy.

The job I'll never forget: There are a lot of them. The most recent one was when Hurricane Fiona came through here in September 2022 — the worst hurricane to ever hit Canada, I think. The area had no power for over two weeks. We had seven trucks going nonstop during those two weeks to keep the sewage lift stations pumped down to prevent overflowing. There was a lot of damage in the province and eight months later people are still repairing their homes and waiting to get their roofs fixed.

My favorite piece of equipment: We have a Vactor 2100 combo unit which we use for sewer flushing and hydroexcavation. It's a real versatile piece of equipment for us. We have a new one ordered but delivery has been delayed due to difficulty of getting parts and the lack of welders.

Most challenging site I've worked on: There was a motor vehicle accident here in 2010 involving a half-ton pickup and an oil truck hauling waste oil. The load of oil went into a river. We spent three months with six or seven vacuum trucks collecting the oil. I had to set up

a tank farm to hold the oil and water we collected to wait for transport to be shipped away. It was a long three months to organize things and keep everybody working without getting overly tired.

Oops, I wish I could take this one back: There had been a small fish plant here. When the owners went bankrupt they just walked out and left the fish and lobsters. We were contacted to go in and vacuum it out, clean it up and wash it down. But I didn't realize how long it had been from the time the owners walked away from it and when we got that contract. When we got in there, we quickly realized

it was full of dead fish and lobsters. The smell, the maggots, the rotten fish, rats — it was quite an experience. It took us about three days.

He met me at the truck and asked me if I wouldn't mind walking lightly across his grass so I wouldn't leave any footprints. I told him I'd do my best. Obviously I left footprints and hose marks but he didn't say anything.

If I could change one industry regulation, it would be: Other than the unregulated camera situation, things are really good right now.

Best piece of small business advice I've heard: It's not so much what I've heard but my thing has always been, "failure is not an option." You do what you have to do to make things work and get through the day. You take the good times with the bad.



Massachusetts Limits Scope of Onsite Rules Update

ver the summer, Massachusetts officials updated onsite rules to address nitrogen pollution, but the new rules are more limited than originally proposed.

In 2022, when officials first suggested changing the rules, widespread public opposition caused the state to hold several public hearings and extend its deadline for public comments. The proposed changes would have allowed the state Department of Environmental Quality to designate nitrogen-sensitive areas along the entire Massachusetts coast and on its islands. Onsite system owners in designated areas would have faced a tight deadline to upgrade their systems to include nitrogen-reducing technology. The updated rules focus only on Cape Cod.

Municipalities in designated nitrogen-sensitive areas will have two years to acquire a watershed permit that will last 20 years and allow them to apply a range of nitrogen pollution remedies such as municipal sewer connections and advanced onsite systems, news reports said. If a municipality does not acquire a permit, its residents will be required to upgrade onsite systems on their own.

The proposed rules set a five-year time limit for homeowners to improve systems in the absence of a watershed permit. In the updated rules, the five-year clock doesn't start until the end of the two-year window for a watershed permit application.

Democratic State Sen. Julian Cyr, who represents Cape Cod and the islands of Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard, said he expects most municipalities will apply for the permits. Earlier this year he said most communities already meet the permit requirement because of their work on comprehensive watershed management plans. The final onsite rules streamline transformation of those comprehensive watershed plans into the new watershed permits.

According to information compiled by the Association to Preserve Cape Cod, about 90% of bays along the cape had unacceptable levels of nitrogen in 2022 compared to 68% of bays in 2019.

In a related action, town of Dartmouth residents approved the potential expenditure of \$200,000 for legal counsel that may be needed to represent the town in conjunction with the state's new onsite rules. If the money is not spent within a year, it will return to the town's general fund.

Because of the cost of nitrogen-reducing systems, Dartmouth citizens and their government were vocal in opposing the proposed rules. Dartmouth is not

included in the final rules. In a statement the Department of Environmental Quality said communities on the state's southern coast, such as Dartmouth, have not had the same time as Cape Cod communities to plan for nutrient reduction. The department said it intends to assist communities outside the cape with nutrient pollution planning.

The budget proposed by Democratic Gov. Maura Healey calls for tax rebates of up to \$12,000 for homeowners who upgrade their onsite systems.

Florida

Officials in Martin County put a 60-day delay on a new sewer system for two communities now served by onsite systems. The decision came after residents voiced concerns about the cost of hooking up to municipal sewer.

As part of its goal to eliminate septic tanks within 10 years, the county specified 1,000 homes in Port Salerno and New Monrovia must connect to a future municipal sewer system. After completion of the system in 2025, residents would have one year to connect at a cost of about \$12,000, reported WPTV of West Palm Beach. If that cost were spread over 20 years of payments added to tax bills, each homeowner would pay about \$15,000.

County commissioners delayed the system to find out what other state and federal funds might be available. Commissioners said each \$1,000 of reduction in connection cost assessment for a homeowner requires \$1 million from other sources. Grants would cover about half of the system's \$24.3 million cost.

Martin County lies between Lake Okeechobee and the Atlantic Ocean.

Washington State

The state is distributing \$313 million in grants and loans for clean water projects, including onsite work. The Regional Onsite Sewage System Loan Program will receive more than \$15 million to assist homeowners with onsite repairs or upgrades. This is a continuing project of the state Ecology and Health departments, and the nonprofit third-party lender Craft3.

Thirty-seven nonpoint pollution projects will receive \$43.9 million. Projects include stabilizing stream banks in the Hangman Creek watershed near Spokane and establishing a watershed conservation fund in Jefferson County, which covers part of the Olympic Peninsula.

Money for these projects comes from the state and the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law signed by President Joe Biden in 2021.

Oklahoma

A judge sentenced the owner of an onsite installation company to life in prison without parole for killing his employee and burying his body beneath a septic tank.

When Brent Mack went missing in September 2021, Daniel Triplett, of Guthrie, Oklahoma, told police he had fired Mack, paid him \$1,000 in severance, and dropped him off at a laundromat. Using a search warrant, investigators looked at a list of recent installations by Triplett and focused on the job done on the day Mack went missing.

Surveillance video showed Triplett and Mack working at the job site. Mack climbed down into a septic tank hole but never appeared in the video again, and although the video showed two people arriving at the site, only one was seen leaving.

Investigators dug up the tank and beneath it found a body and a wallet containing Mack's ID. They said Triplett shot Mack in the back and used a backhoe to bury him. **P**
