## Fill It Up, but Don't Dump It Out!

Pumpers continue to grapple with the challenge of more calls for periodic pumping and dwindling affordable disposal sites

eptic pumpers are sometimes faced with a Catch-22 situation. The county or state wants you to empty customers' septic tanks periodically — in many states and regions this is mandated. But once you get the sludge into the tank, these same governments can become uninterested in how you get rid of it. Pick up the load, sure. That's a good idea. But dumping it, well that's another matter.

A pumper's first thought might be to leave the load at an area municipal plant where operators are used to treating wastewater and releasing clean water back into the environment. Well, more and more often, the answer is "No, we're concerned about our system's treatment capacity and all of this septic waste might cause problems."

So then the pumper might think, "Well, OK, I can always land-apply septage if the treatment plant won't take it." Wrong. Maybe it's winter and the state won't allow spreading on frozen ground. Or neighbors will object to land application, so you can't do that either.

So the pumper idles in his truck with a tank full of waste that nobody wants to handle locally. The next option is driving it over a county or two where you might find a willing plant to process the waste.

Luckily, disposal isn't always an issue. I talk to pumpers every day and the topic of disposal invariably comes up. If the pumper has a receptive municipal plant and the per-gallon fee isn't out of control, it's no problem. Or if the pumper is in a rural area in a state that doesn't object to land application, that can be an economic way to go.

But you have to feel for the small-business pumpers who find themselves in an area where no reasonable disposal options exist. This challenge is hurting their livelihood and the pocketbooks of their customers who rely on a septic system.

### LAND APPLICATION LIMITS

Consider what pumpers are going through in Sundance, Wyoming, these days. The state Department of Environmental Quality rules for septage land application have become stricter in recent years. And at the same time, the city of Sundance doesn't want to allow septage to be added to its city wastewater lagoons. So it's becoming pretty difficult for pumpers

to thread the needle to find a solution.

According to a report in the *Sundance Times*, the 2018 DEQ rules were changed to state that land-spreading can only be done on property where septic tanks are pumped. Additionally, dumping must happen at least 1,000 feet from adjacent property owners and 300 feet from a private road, body of water or stream. This restricts pumpers from devising a plan to spread waste on their own property or contracted lands.

You have to feel for the small-business pumpers who find themselves in an area where no reasonable disposal options exist. This challenge is hurting their livelihood and the pocketbooks of their customers who rely on a septic system.

But at the same time, the city does not want to agree to requests from area pumpers to dump at municipal lagoons that take waste from residents using the sewer system. There is enough capacity to take the waste, but a concern that the concentrated septic sludge will throw off the chemistry in the lagoons and lead to expensive dredging operations.

The public works director, Mac Erickson, recommends local officials refuse to take on the septic waste from outside the city limits.

"If we start taking on a thousand gallons at a time of sludge, it's going to be quite the burden on our lagoon [with] the possibility of some contaminants coming in there that we don't want and damaging or killing the bugs in the lagoon," he said during a meeting on the issue. "We certainly don't want to be the bad guys, but I think it's in the city's best interests to protect what we have."

You know where this all leaves local pumpers. In limbo.



### **NEW SEPTAGE PLANT**

Some communities are seeking solutions to better handle septic waste. Montana's Flathead County just agreed to purchase nearly 37 acres of land to develop a septage treatment operation, according to a report in the *Daily Interlake* in Kalispell, Montana. The county will spend \$1.5 million for the land and about \$15 million in American Rescue Plan Act and state Department of Natural Resources and Conservation money on the project.

Sludge from an estimated 30,000 septic systems serving a large rural area will be trucked to the facility and treated, with effluent flowing into the adjacent Lakeside Water and Sewer District treatment plant and dried cake converted into compost at the site.

As you might expect, there were objections to the plan from neighbors of the septage treatment site. Nearby resident Jennifer Tipton argued, "This will concentrate the entire county's waste around my family and neighbors and near Flathead Lake." Another neighbor said the plan would have a negative impact on his property. "It does not take a genius to figure out no homeowner wants the county to build a septage biowaste composting facility next to their property," said Jason Mahlen.

But local officials were adamant that a solution is necessary to provide a way to treat waste being generated by rural taxpayers and caused, in part, by increasing development in the popular region. The county reported that 40,000 gallons of septage must be pumped daily and that waste has to go somewhere.

"We have great concerns about how those septic tanks will be pumped going forward," said Cynthia Murray, general manager of the Evergreen Water and Sewer District. "This facility is so important for the future. What the county is doing is forward-thinking and responsible for the citizens of the county."

### **SOLUTIONS NEEDED**

I agree with Murray that this plan is forward-thinking on the part of the county. Septage treatment is not some bright and shiny government project that generates positive attention. And as it is shown in this case, such a project can turn out to be a political liability for local officials who support it.

But if there is anything we should be spending taxpayer money on right now, it's these important infrastructure projects that keep our communities moving. Across the country, roads, bridges, airports, power grid and — most certainly — our wastewater systems are aging and in need of repair. Too often necessary upgrades to infrastructure have been put off in favor of other types of spending, and we need to make up for it now.

And I would like to call out any infrastructure attention given to decentralized wastewater needs and not just concentrated on maintaining and expanding the big pipe of municipal sewer. The National Onsite Wastewater Recycling Association has fought for years to get our onsite infrastructure a bigger piece of the federal funding pie, and more success has been reported recently.

It's true that more than one-quarter of U.S. residents handle their waste through septic systems. So as an industry we shouldn't be shy about demanding help for our customers who often struggle financially to maintain proper functioning treatment of their household waste stream. We are the best advocates for effective management of rural waste and promoting a cleaner environment for the benefit of all. **P**



uess I'm still on my two weeks.

That's the joke Brian Russell continues to make occasionally, more than two decades after taking over the fieldwork for A-1 Septic Tank Cleaning from his father-in-law, Henry Howland Jr. What was initially proposed as a two-week gig while Howland recovered from a back injury has morphed into Brian and wife Tamara running the longtime Topeka, Kansas, septic company, now in its 76th year.

"I just wanted to see it go on more than anything," Tamara says of her journey into the septic trade.

With two older siblings uninterested in getting into the family business, Tamara decided to take on the role. She got further involved in 2002 when her father stepped back from his job duties, and since 2009, when he died, she and Brian have led the company full time.

Their plan is to keep up what has made the company successful for decades — including their 16-year-old vacuum truck — with hopes that potentially a fourth generation, their son Lukas, could continue A-1 Septic Tank Cleaning's legacy down the line.

### THE FAMILY TRADE

A-1 Septic Tank Cleaning started with Tamara's grandfather, Henry Howland Sr., in 1947. He ran the company full time until 1973, when Tamara's father took over. From there, operations just naturally transitioned to yet another generation of the family.

"I've done little things here and there for as long as I can remember, whether answering the phone for my dad or helping with the books," Tamara says. "Then in 2002, my dad said he was going to step back and let me do more, but he continued to answer the phone until he passed away."

All these years, A-1 Septic has kept it simple as a one-truck company. For a time, Tamara says her father considered adding a second truck to bring her brother into the company, but that didn't pan out. A-1 Septic stayed a one-truck operation.

"I also think my dad was having thoughts about the expense of a second truck," Tamara says. "Brian and I haven't really considered adding a second truck either. We're happy maintaining what we've already built."

A-1 Septic has stayed around its home base of Topeka, typically traveling no more than about 30 miles for a job. Perhaps the most significant change over the years has been the amount and makeup of A-1 Septic's workload

as the Topeka community has grown. More houses have been built in areas with no sewer service. More restaurants now exist and local dog food plants Hill's Pet Nutrition and J.M. Smucker's have grown.

"We do more commercial work now than my dad did," Tamara says. "Topeka has grown. More restaurants have popped up over the years, and we do a lot of grease trap cleaning. That's one thing. And two, we've done a lot of work for the dog food plants. My dad did Hill's Pet Nutrition back in the day, but they hadn't grown as large as they have now in the area. When we've had a contract with them, Brian has had to do it almost every day."

### A RELIABLE RIG

Among the many constants for A-1 Septic is its service truck nicknamed Big Blue, a 2008 Peterbilt 340 from Transway Systems. Back in its youth in 2009 it was even one of Pumper's featured Classy Trucks.

"That was the last truck my dad kind of had a say on as far as how everything was set up and how it was ordered," Tamara says. She and Brian flew to Buffalo, New York, to pick it up. She says she remembers calling her dad from the road while driving it back to Kansas.

"I called him from somewhere around Iowa and said, 'This thing is huge. I'm going to call it Big Blue.' So Big Blue has stuck all these years," Tamara says. "My dad always wanted one of his trucks to be featured in Classy Trucks, but he had never submitted any. So I told Brian when we were driving it back that I was going to submit it for Classy Trucks after we got it lettered. We surprised my dad. We didn't tell him that we were going to do it. So when we got selected, he was amazed. He passed away that year it was featured, but he got to see the truck in there. That was the important part."

Big Blue carries a 3,600-gallon Progress aluminum tank, with vacuum created by a Masport HXL 400 pump. The truck has a PACCAR PX-8 power plant tied to a 10-speed Fuller transmission (Eaton Vehicle Group) transmission. Work features include a three-stage telescopic hoist, matching aluminum toolboxes, and a custom "It's Time" indicator float gauge. Exterior accents include aluminum hose trays, diamond-plate aluminum hose guard on the tank and aluminum wheels.

Keeping the truck this long wasn't necessarily the original plan. Tamara's dad used to maintain a five-year cycle for changing out trucks.

"The reason he did the five-year cycle is he thought it was better to get rid of a truck before it got too many miles on it and he wanted to be able to still get something out of it. I think that was his thought," Tamara says. "We weren't really planning on keeping the truck this long. It just kind of happened that way. Originally we thought maybe 10 years. But we had

so many issues with the truck in the beginning before we got it running right, I think we just developed an attitude of, 'Nope, we'll just keep this one going.""

In 2008, Big Blue was one of the earliest models engineered for low emissions, so some tweaking was unfortunately necessary before it became the reliable workhorse it is today after traveling 220,000 miles.

"There were problems with the diesel particulate filter and the turbo," Tamara says. "It was all under warranty, but it took about four years to get through all of that. Since then, it's been pretty good. There

have been little things here and there, but Brian does his best to take care of it. It gets babied."

A-1 Septic has a shop to store Big Blue. As long as the truck has already been in service, Tamara says the hope is that they can get another 10 years out of it.

"However long it will last," she says. "Brian keeps saying he's going to retire in maybe 10 years, so he's hoping it lasts that long."

### **GREASE SERVICE**

A-1 Septic has benefited

from some local regulations. For about a decade, restaurants have been required to clean grease traps quarterly. That coupled with Topeka's growth and the increase in the number of restaurants has meant significantly more grease trap work than the company used to handle.

"When that regulation started, that's when grease trap work really picked up for us. It makes up maybe 40% of our work now," Tamara says. "My dad was doing grease trap work, but he just didn't have as much to do back then. It was maybe 10% of his workload."

A-1 Septic maintains simple verbal contracts with its grease trap customers.

"If they want us to do it, we just get them on the schedule," Tamara says. "Some are three months, some are two months. It just depends on the particular situation; how bad their grease trap gets and what the city says they need done."

Another helpful regulation is the requirement for riser installation at the time of a home sale, which has been in place for about 20 years. It keeps Brian focused on profitable pumping rather than searching for septic tanks and excavating to access them, Tamara says.

"Brian doesn't do any locating or digging to get to a tank," she says. "If there's one that needs it, we have excavating companies we refer for that because one person could be spending hours locating and digging when they could be pumping instead. We don't have to call the excavating company very often. Usually that's one of the questions we ask. Do you have a riser? If they say no we see if they can have it uncovered before we get there. A lot of times homeowners will do it themselves."

### **GENERATION NEXT?**

Since 2009, A-1 Septic's staff has been solely Brian and Tamara, outside of one year when their son Lukas, 31, joined the team.

"We did that to see if it was something he might consider later on down the road," Tamara says. "He's doing his own thing right now, so we'll see. I'm sure if something happened and we had to be away and one of our regular customers called, he'd get in the truck and go. We keep his hauler's license current."

In the meantime, Brian and Tamara, both 53, are looking at another decade of running Big Blue and providing Topeka's community with quality septic service for almost eight decades.

"We're just saving money and investing," Tamara says. "We'll keep operating how we always have."


### A helping hand

Septic pumping competition isn't cutthroat in Topeka, Kansas. For as long as A-1 Septic Tank Cleaning has been in business, the company has maintained friendly relationships with other area pumpers.

"Everybody here is friendly," co-owner Tamara Russell says. "There are really only three septic pumping companies locally. Everyone is small. Just one or two truck operations. Usually if something happens, someone is able to help."

She recalls one instance where the truck of one of those competitors/friends broke down while transporting a full load. Her husband Brian met up with the stranded pumper to transfer the load to the A-1 Septic truck for disposal. "These friendly relationships with competitors have happened naturally," Tamara says. "There is plenty of work to go around so we just help each other out."



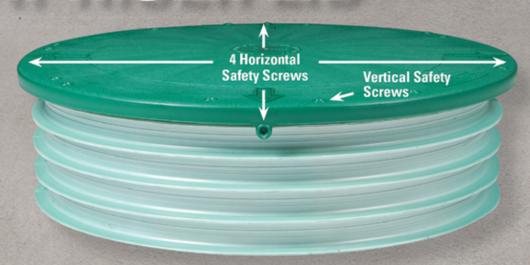

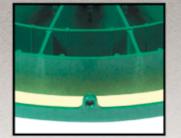



## Getting to the Root of Pipe or Tank Infiltration

Trees offer many benefits to your customer's profits, as long as their underground growth doesn't interfere with proper septic system function

esearch has shown trees can provide up to \$7 in annual benefits for every \$1 invested in caring for them. Benefits include increased property values, pollution control and energy savings, and they are beautiful! Unfortunately, tree roots can cause problems in septic systems.

Roots are estimated to make up 20 to 40% of the total biomass of trees. Trees have two types of root sizes — coarse and fine. Coarse roots (more than 1/12 inches in diameter) anchor the tree in the soil and transport water from deeper soil horizons. Fine roots (up to 1/12 inches in diameter) uptake water and nutrients.

The typical rule of thumb has been to keep trees 20 feet or more away from the septic system, but increasing this distance is undoubtedly a good idea for new tree plantings. Trees known for seeking water, such as poplar, maple, willow and elm, should be planted at least 50 feet away from the septic system. Planting smaller ornamental trees nearby is advisable since their roots will be less extensive.

If/when the top of the barrier deteriorates or is damaged from traffic/activity, the roots will travel over the top of the barrier and continue to cause problems.

Suppose you live in a part of the U.S. that has experienced drought conditions. In that case, the recommended separation distance between trees and the septic system may not effectively limit the problem as expected. Trees may enhance fine root growth during droughts and form deeper coarse roots to increase water uptake. Trees that have adapted to dry climates tend to have higher root-to-plant ratios, and research shows this happens during severe droughts in non-arid environments.

### WHERE THEY TRAVEL

The first location where tree roots commonly cause problems is the building sewer to the first tank. The critical issue here is determining how the tree root

is getting into the pipe and repairing it. A pipe inspection camera can aid in diagnosing this issue. It may be because the pipe is of inferior quality, cracked or otherwise damaged. Be aware that tree roots may crush or lift the pipes, creating a location for debris to catch and freezing to occur.

Proper repair includes cutting out the root entirely and relaying the pipe at the appropriate grade. If the pipe is not up to current standards, the entire pipe from the source to the tank should be replaced. With this repair, you may damage the tree to the point that the tree will die. With high-value trees, check with an arborist if you need clarification.

With tree roots in septic and pump tanks or advanced pretreatment units, the question is the same as solid pipe — how are they getting in? A service provider must remove the roots, and the source for entry must be blocked permanently. Left unchecked, the roots can cause backup into homes due to their aggressive growth.

Tree roots can make their way into and around conventional systems. Growing around the system is not a problem, but the root must be physically removed if it gets into the perforated pipe. The quickest way to deal with this issue is physical means of removal (jets, augers, etc.).

Unless the tree is cut down or the system is replaced in another location, physical removal must be immediately followed with applications of a chemical root killer or installation of a mechanical and/or chemical barrier. Otherwise, the plant regrows those roots vigorously. If a chemical is used, it will be for the system's life; although the frequency of re-treatment may diminish, the need never goes away.

### **BUILDING BARRIERS**

A mechanical barrier (sometimes called a tree root deflector) is typically

made of plastic or metal installed vertically into the soil. It forms a barrier that redirects or restricts the growth of tree roots, preventing them from spreading into unwanted areas. These barriers are designed to direct roots down and away from the septic system component.

Some walls are impregnated with cupric acid or trifluralin to inhibit the growth of all tree roots they encounter. Care should be taken as these chemicals are toxic to humans. Special attention during installation is needed at every joint of either physical or chemical barriers, as roots can easily penetrate and defeat the wall.

During installation, exceptional care must be paid to ensure the extension of the barrier below the maximum depth the roots will penetrate. If you need more clarification on this depth, it is another time to discuss the issue with a local arborist. It would be best to be careful to install them only a short distance from the tree, or it may need more root growth to sustain its height and water/nutrient needs.



Also, depending on your location, the depth of UV penetration may be several inches, so the barrier product must be very resistant to this. If/when the top of the barrier deteriorates or is damaged from traffic/activity, the roots will travel over the top of the barrier and continue to cause problems.

Trees add aesthetic beauty to a property, increase value, save on air conditioning and assist in preventing runoff and erosion. They are valuable resources; we must consider how they can impact septic systems.

## So You Want to Expand Your Service Menu? Proceed Carefully!

Before you buy equipment and add staff to pursue a new wastewater specialty, evaluate your idea using the three P's

built a deck out on the dune. It turned out well. Not perfect — when you do the work, you always see the minor imperfections no one else notices — but overall, I was satisfied.

"That looks great," a neighbor said. "You could start a business building decks." Hmm, I thought. I could. After all:

- Home improvement spending has spiked because of higher home prices; homeowners who might have moved up have chosen to improve what they own instead.
- Finding people to do that work is tough; 90% of homebuilders report
  a shortage of carpenters, according to a National Association of Home
  Builders survey.
- There's definitely a market; a deck is a relatively inexpensive way to meet the stereotypical "space for entertaining" desire of every homeowner on an HGTV show.
- No capital is required; I already own all the tools I need.

So, yes. I could start a deck-building business — but that doesn't mean I should.

When asked how he validates business ideas, here's what HubSpot co-founder Dharmesh Shah had to say:

The most dangerous ideas are not the bad ideas. Those you can discard easily. The dangerous ideas are the ones that are good — but not great. Yes, it could work, and yes, I could do it — but that doesn't mean I should.

### **PROFIT POTENTIAL**

It's not about the failure rate — I'm actually OK with that. It's that good ideas eat up a lot of time/calories, leaving little time for the great ideas.

Why would starting a deck-building business be such a dangerous idea? At face value, it wouldn't.

- Product/market fit? Check.
- Skills/market fit? Check. While I'm no genius, I would be smart enough to walk away from projects beyond my skill level.
- Reasonable profit potential? Check. Especially now; the supply and demand curves would definitely be my friend.

But that still doesn't mean I should. I enjoyed building my deck. But I don't want to build your deck. And I definitely don't want to spend all day, every day building decks.

That's the other half of Shah's could/should equation. Here's his simple framework for judging ideas:

The beauty of starting or expanding a business is that you are free to choose what kind of business. Not the business you could start, but the business you should start.

**Potential:** If it worked, how big could it be?

**Probability:** What are the chances it will work?

**Proximity:** How close is this to things I care about, know about, or am passionate about?

How you weigh each category depends on your situation. Early on, Shah focused heavily on probability for success; risk is not your friend when your primary goal is putting food on the table.

### **EXAMINE POTENTIAL RETURNS**

"Today," Shah says, with a \$17 billion company under his belt, "I solve mostly for numbers 1 and 3: What has great potential that I'm passionate about? (Even if I fail, I'll have no regrets, because I cared enough about it)."

And that's where the deck-building business falls apart for me. Probability of success is high. Growth potential? Sure — but scaling would require hiring and managing and infrastructure, and all the stuff I wanted to stop doing when I left a corporate job.

That only adds to the proximity problem; not only do I not want to manage dozens of people, I don't really want to build decks every day. I like building decks for me and mine. I wouldn't like building decks for other people.

And I'm fortunate to have other work I enjoy more.

Trying to decide whether starting a particular business or adding a new service to your existing business makes sense for you? First, consider your situation. 
### DO WHAT YOU LOVE

The beauty of starting or expanding a business is that you are free to choose what kind of business. Not the business you could start, but the business you should start. Because we all have to make a living. But we also need to live.







## Sand filtration system for site with high water table

Problem: A three-bedroom home was being built on a tight lot in Norwalk, Ohio. The property has a perched seasonal high water table at 20 inches below grade, and the



homeowner wanted the system to be in the front yard to preserve backyard space. The system would also need a nonstandard configuration to meet multiple setback requirements.

Solution: A shallow L-shaped mound was designed to meet the setbacks from the road, driveway and property line. A pump to a gravity Eljen GSF system was chosen to allow for a 1-foot depth credit to the seasonal high water table. Flenner Water Well and Excavating installed the mound system, which included 27 A42 GSF modules as well as a dual-chamber 1,500-gallon septic tank and a 500-gallon pump chamber from Spoerr Precast. The mound's bed area has one row of A42 modules, and measures 4 feet wide by 108 feet long, with an overall basal area of 16 feet wide by 121 feet long. Result: The depth credit reduced the amount of sand needed for the site, producing a shallower mound. # ATU replaced collapsed septic system on water-front property

Problem: Waterfront homeowners in Cheboygen County, Michigan, had their septic tank collapse and needed to install a new system to ser-

vice both the family home and a small cottage on the property.

**Solution: SludgeHammer** initially proposed an advanced treatment system and subsurface dripfield new system that would fit in the space between the buildings. County regulators objected because a geothermal system was already occupying that space. Instead, the county waived the required 100-foot setback from the lake so the dripfield could be installed on the lake side of the house. The county approved the SludgeHammer technology because it moved the disposal point much closer to the surface and further from the water table, which would protect the lake water quality.

**Result:** The latest test with up to 10 mg/L BOD and TSS and a Total Nitrogen of 17 mg/L confirmed the county's decision. As an added bonus, the homeowners no longer have to spread high-phosphate fertilizer on their lakefront lawn, further reducing nutrient runoff. **231-348-5866**; www.sludgehammer.net

# Treatment units specified in environmentally sensitive area

Problem: Two neighboring residences located on Three Mile Harbor in East Hampton, New York, had collapsing cesspools that needed to be replaced with a low-nitrogen treatment unit pursuant to new sanitary mandates implemented by the town and county. The project was complicated by the properties' close proximity to the harbor and the resultant high-water table.



Solution: Advanced Wastewater Solutions and A&A Sewer and Drain teamed up to replace the failing cesspools with FujiClean CEN5 onsite treatment units leading into a pressurized shallow drainfield consisting of an Orenco Simplex Pump Station discharging into two rows of chambered drainfield. The CEN units are designed to remove upwards of 80% of nitrogen from the wastewater effluent through contact filtration treatment whereby the wastewater is recirculated through aerobic and anaerobic chambers in direct contact with fixed film media, facilitating biological digestion and mechanical filtration. The pressurized shallow drainfield further reduces total nitrogen and provides treatment of other contaminants by evenly distributing the effluent within 18 inches of the topsoil horizon where increased microbial activity and nutrient absorption occurs.

**Result:** Pursuant to a special emergency replacement program adopted by Suffolk County, the contractors were able to bypass the usual monthslong sanitary design and approval process and replace both failed cesspools in a total of three days. **207-406-2927**; www.fujicleanusa.com

Problem: A homeowner in Massachusetts was in the process of a septic repair installation when they noticed a plastic PVC candy cane being installed in the yard. Disturbed by the appearance and potential for odor, they asked the installer for another option.

# Water reuse helps facility go green

Problem: A veterans health clinic in Sedalia, Missouri, was required to accumulate Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design points to receive government funding. Wa-

ter conservation as well as waste reduction needed to be considered.

Solution: J-Squared Engineering reached out to Webtrol Pumps to provide an NSRF350 waste treatment system that could provide water reuse. They proposed a **BioBarrier MBR** system, which has met NSF 350 standards and accreditation. Graywater from the facility was directed to a tank containing the device, where it was treated and stored in a compartment containing a Webtrol submersible pump, which pumps into the restroom systems of water closets and flush valves. By reusing graywater for restroom use, the facility saves on freshwater needs and reduces flow into the city sewer system.

Result: The MBR unit was installed on the side of the facility and landscaped, while providing access for maintenance. The reused water contains no contaminants, including *E. coli*, due to the high filtration of the MBR. The facility was granted LEED points, utility bills are reduced, and the environment is a little cleaner due to less wastewater in the sewer

# Everything, Including Development, Is Bigger in Texas

This pumping and onsite company hopes improving onsite technology and water reuse efforts will preserve a dwindling resource for a fast-growing populace

In Snapshot, we talk to a member of a state, provincial or national trade association in the decentralized wastewater industry. This time we visit a member of Texas On-Site Wastewater Association.

**Name and title or job description:** Patrick Kern, vice president, and Chase Kern, general manager

**Business name and location:** Paramount Wastewater Solutions LLC, Temple, Texas

**Services we offer:** Septic pumping, roll-off services for picking up dry sludge, and a commercial Orenco dealer; retail store and sell septic products, retail and wholesale, to contractors

Age: Patrick 56, Chase 27

**Years in the industry: Patrick:** I've been in it 28 years. I was previously a real estate appraiser. With the sprawl from the cities into the suburbs, I saw how people were needing onsite systems. The appraisal industry wasn't doing real well at the time so I was looking to make a change and moved over into septic.

**Chase:** I grew up with it but professionally I've been here three years to help my parents run the business.

**Association involvement: Patrick:** I've been a member of the Texas On-Site Wastewater Association for about 10 years. I am on the board of directors and have served on several committees.

Benefits of belonging to the association: Patrick: TOWA is very active. It's an intermediary between our members and the regulators. We try to prevent overreaching regulation, police our members, work with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for suggestions on research and development, and we're active in the legislative process. We try to educate the members — for example, we have really been active on stressing the importance of securing tank lids and secondary fall prevention.

**Chase:** TOWA is good for advocacy. It really does an excellent job visiting the capitol, representing the contractors, coming up with realistic solutions on the regulations side, and informing the legislature on what they should proceed with.

**Biggest issue facing your association right now: Patrick:** Keeping up with the big influx of people into Texas is a challenge. We have

diminishing water levels and have to keep them clean. We have an excellent group of installers and designers but we're continually trying to improve the process. There's a lot of research going into reuse and looking at other avenues to prevent groundwater contamination.

**Our crew includes: Patrick:** We have a staff of 16. My wife, Krista Kern, is the president and chief financial officer. Our operations manager David Wharton handles the day-to-day trucking operation. Our sales manager Hannah Fischer controls most of our retail and wholesale sales.

**Typical day on the job: Patrick:** When I arrive I speak with the managers and work on the policies, processes and procedures — trying to hone that in and help them, make their lives easier. They carry the weight around here and I try to use my experience to help them out.

Chase: My dad is specialized in and really good at decentralized wastewater treatment and treatment of commercial sites and does a lot of

consulting. He and Hannah work together on that. When I come into the office I talk with Hannah about the sales for the day as well as stocking different products. Once she and I are on the same page I talk with David about the status of trucks and drivers. Then I move to our customer service representatives and make sure customers are receiving availability and pricing on good terms and that we are keeping a healthy cushion on when we're booking out jobs.

The job I'll never forget: Patrick: We had a call come in one night around 8 p.m. It was a woman whose husband had been deployed overseas and she couldn't flush any of her toilets. Normally we would try to push somebody off until the next day but she had kids and this was a special situation so we headed out. My wife and I and one other employee were the only ones available. We ended up having to dig it up. There was a huge root ball in the line. In the middle of all that I noticed my wife had disappeared — she was only there for emotional support, anyway. I looked up and she and the woman were having a glass of wine while we were toiling away. It was about 3 in the morning when we got done but we got her taken care of.

**My favorite piece of equipment: Patrick:** I like the larger vacuum trucks — 4,000 gallons or more (Mack and Freightliners built out by American Tank with aluminum or steel tanks and National Vacuum Equipment blowers or Fruitland pumps). I also like our RIDGID locators and our Bobcat mini excavator, which has worked out wonderfully for digging up systems.

**Chase:** I really enjoy our vehicle tracker software from Samsara. That has been extremely helpful in keeping up with the status of the trucks, telemetry, keeping track of maintenance. We utilize the GPS gateways with the dual-facing cameras to help with complaints, accidents and harsh events.

**Most challenging site I've worked on: Patrick:** The deep lift stations, the septic systems that are downhill, are the most challenging. To overcome that, we use a booster which injects air into the vacuum line to help lift the waste. And we use an NVE 4310 blower to assist us.

**Oops, I wish I could take this one back: Patrick:** I'm always looking for new technology but one time I got a little over my skis with a new treatment unit. We put numerous ones in the ground before I realized there were problems. I had to go back and make it right with my customers when they started having issues. Another thing to watch out for is buying used equipment from auctions. I've learned my lesson there.

Chase: We tried to take a swing at pumping out a freshwater clarifier

at a municipality that we weren't ready for. We didn't have our blower yet. We were down there in waders with pressure washers in the middle of the summer, trying to get it out. We couldn't quite get the whole job done and had to call in another group to help us.

The craziest question I've been asked by a customer: Chase: We get calls from people asking why their system is full if they just had it pumped. We constantly have to educate customers. We have Septic 101 on our website.

If I could change one industry regulation, it would be: Patrick: One thing we have been trying to do in TOWA is get a pumper course for basic knowledge, teaching people outside the industry who have pump trucks how to not damage the equipment, not leave risers open where children or pets could fall in. We don't want them to do more damage than good.

Right now there is no legal requirement to attend classes to learn about septic systems. You could damage media, burn out pumps, knock off floats with the vacuum hoses, and cause the homeowner problems.

**Chase:** Whoever touches a septic system, even to pump it out, needs to be educated on the system. You shouldn't be able to just buy a truck and get into servicing. And it goes beyond just you touching the system. The homeowner is standing over your shoulder asking you questions about how it works, trusting that you know something about it. Sometimes these guys give advice that is off-the-wall crazy stuff.

**Best piece of small business advice I've heard: Patrick:** You have to know your costs before you can quote a price to a customer. And maintenance, maintenance, maintenance on trucks.

**Chase:** Watch your costs and don't cheat yourself on margin.

If I wasn't working in the wastewater industry, I would: Patrick: Both of us have the same answer — real estate development. We were both real estate appraisers at one time.

**Crystal ball time – This is my outlook for the wastewater industry: Patrick:** In Texas, we have diminishing potable and freshwater levels and I'd like to see steps to conserve and reuse. Texas is a big rainwater reuse state. Instead of putting potable water on lawns, we're trying to get people to reuse wastewater or use rainwater. An old oil man once told me, "Water is the next oil in Texas." **P**

# Michigan launches fund for food business onsite work

he Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development has launched a \$30 million fund to help food businesses pay the cost of onsite wastewater treatment systems, several news outlets reported.

The businesses must pay the full cost upfront, but they may be reimbursed for up to 50% of total project costs. Among those are site work, engineering design, installation and materials. Payments are limited depending on daily flows. For example, a project of up to 750 gpd is eligible for a maximum grant of \$225,000. On the top end, a project for more than 20,000 gpd is eligible for the maximum grant of \$2 million.

Money from the new Wastewater Infrastructure Fund is intended to help businesses meet requirements for groundwater discharge permits, says the state website detailing the fund. There is a focus on processing of fruit, vegetables, dairy products, meat, eggs and grain.

Jamie Zmitko-Somers, director of the department's agriculture development division, told *Crain's Grand Rapids Business*, "A lot of these processing facilities are in rural communities, and the disadvantage for them is they do not have municipal waste systems that they can send their waste to where it's treated."

Scott Newman-Bale, CEO of Short's Brewing Co. LLC, told Crain's that in 2013 the brewery's wastewater output exceeded the treatment capacity of its home community of Elk Rapids, located on a bay of Lake Michigan. The brewery produces about 4.5 gallons of wastewater for each gallon of finished beer, he said. To solve the problem, he said, the company built its own \$2 million wastewater treatment system, which came online in 2015.

#### **South Carolina**

The Charleston Waterkeeper and Coastal Conservation League recently asked a judge to temporarily ban some septic tank permit approvals. The ban would last until the state updates its permit process to allow for rising seas and increasing storms.

Only large-scale housing developments would be affected along with homes within 200 feet of state waters in coastal counties, reported *The Post and Courier* of Charleston. Single-family homeowners replacing septic tanks would not be affected.

Attorney Leslie Lenhardt, representing the two groups, said the state's coastal act of 1977 was passed before scientists fully understood how climate change would impact modern septic systems. She said permitting rules need to be adjusted to account for that.

Around Charleston, sea levels have increased by 10 inches since 1950, and since 2010 levels have increased at a rate of 1 inch every two years.

The judge in the case said she would issue a ruling as soon as possible.

#### **Massachusetts**

Two towns are considering options for complying with the state's new onsite rules intended to reduce nitrogen pollution of coastal waters.


Bourne may hire an outside firm to manage onsite system upgrades required by the new rules. Officials may contract with the town's current management firm, or may partner with some or all of the 15 other towns on Cape Cod to hire a management firm to serve all of them, reported *The Enterprise* in Falmouth.

The town is still also considering whether to apply for a state watershed permit. Under the new rules, towns in areas designated nitrogen-sensitive have two years to apply for a permit that provides a 20-year period to implement nitrogen-reducing strategies such as advanced onsite systems or municipal sewer connections. If towns don't apply for the permit and after the two-year application window closes, residents will have five years to upgrade their onsite systems to advanced treatment.

In Wareham, voters may be asked to decide whether to opt for municipal sewer or pursue onsite upgrades, reported Wareham Week. Patrick MacDonald, the town's public health director, said the options for complying with the new onsite rules are to extend sewer service to the entire town or accept responsibility for the compliance of every private onsite system affected by a watershed permit. He recommended a shift to municipal sewer.

### Oregon

Lincoln County and Oregon State University Extension Service have expanded their onsite replacement program to all low- and middle-income homeowners in Lincoln County. The program provides aid to replace onsite systems damaged by wildfires.





# RULES & REGS

Eligible homeowners can have their systems replaced at no cost, according to the county's website. Eligibility depends on household size and income. For example, a household of one person must have an income no greater than \$38,640, and a household of eight would qualify with an income of no more than \$133,980.

#### **New York**

The village of Speculator, in the Adirondack lake country, passed a time-of-sale ordinance requiring onsite system inspections when properties are transferred. Mayor Jeannette Barrett told the *Adirondack Almanac* that the village has watched similar ordinances pass in nearby communities around Lake George and like those communities there is local concern about the quality of lake water. The new regulations apply to Lake Pleasant, Whitaker Lake and Lewey Lake.

#### Guam

To protect its aquifer, the Guam Environmental Protection Agency may seek to cut off the water supply of people who violate its onsite rules. This is part of a recommendation to the agency's board for combatting increasing groundwater contamination, reported the *Guam Daily Post*.

Guam law forbids onsite systems on parcels of less than half an acre in the groundwater protection zone on the northern section of the island. But an exception to the rule allows parents to split property and pass it on to

their children, and this has been used to bypass the aquifer protections, the recommendation said.

The second piece of the approach is permitting advanced treatment systems, said Brian Bearden who directs the agency's water division. Current law does not allow this and recognizes only three types of toilets: connected to a sewer system, connected to a septic system, or discharging to a hole in the ground.

Guam is a U.S. territory in the western Pacific Ocean about 2,000 miles north of Australia.

#### Oregon

A new onsite assistance program from the Central Oregon Intergovernmental Council will provide financial aid for the repair or replacement of onsite systems. Money will provide reimbursements to people at or below moderate income levels in Crook, Deschutes and Jefferson counties, reported KTVZ News in Bend.

Eligibility varies by county and household size. According to the council's website, the income for a two-person household in Crook County cannot exceed \$58,380 while the income for the same size household in Deschutes County is \$73,140.

#### Virginia

Low-income homeowners in Roanoke County can apply for a free pumpout through the Roanoke Valley-Alleghany Regional Commission. Money from the Virginia Environmental Endowment will cover about 50 pumpouts in the county, reported WDBJ News in Roanoke.

#### Montana

An environmental group has won a round in its lawsuit to stop a state wastewater permit for a large subdivision. In the latest development, a judge rejected the state's motion to dismiss the case. The issue will now be argued in court on its merits.

Upper Missouri Waterkeeper sued in state court to halt the onsite plan for a 175-acre residential development near the Gallatin River. Last year the state Department of Environmental Quality recognized that section of the river as impaired by algal blooms, reported the *Billings Gazette*.


Upper Missouri Waterkeeper asserts that by allowing individual onsite systems with lower individual discharge volumes, DEQ would create an unscientific exemption from standard permit requirements.

#### **Iowa**

Supervisors in Tama County, in central Iowa, voted to decrease the health board's budget after the board made payments totaling about \$13,000 to two homeowners whose onsite systems were improperly approved by the county's former sanitarian.

Carlton Salmons, attorney for the county supervisors, found the payments unlawful for many reasons, reported the *Tama-Toledo News Chronicle*. Supervisors voted to refuse any payments to the homeowners and to transfer \$51,000 from the health department budget into the county's general fund. Supervisor Bill Faircloth said supervisors would find out whether there is a legal way for them to help.

As the supervisors voted, a relative of one of the homeowners said, "We'll see you gentlemen in court."





# SIMPLICITY IS HIGH-VOLUME RECEIVING SCREEN'S CALLING CARD

"Simple but effective" was the goal when ScreencO was designing the Trash Master 600, a high-volume receiving screen for both municipalities and private receiving plants.

The Trash Master 600 Auto Screen uses gravity to separate trash from the waste stream. Using a 6-inch inlet with dual fan spreaders, users have the option to offload vacuum trucks with a single 6-inch stream, or two 4-inch simultaneous streams at rates up to 800 gpm. Wastewater enters the Trash Master in an aluminum or stainless steel hopper which utilizes an 8-inch outlet cam and a 3/8-inch gapped 1/4-inch stainless steel bar screen. The bar screen separates trash from water and allows it to enter a stainless steel U-channel.

"The inlet fans move the flow stream onto the bar screens," says Scott Meyer, owner of ScreencO. "The trash then moves to the U-channel separator to dewater and wash."

Within the U-channel is an alloy steel shaftless screw measuring 11 1/2 inches in diameter. After washing, the shaftless screw acts as a conveyor, moving the trash to a trash bin. "The U-channel separator contains hundreds of elliptical drain holes," Meyer says. "And it's lined with a titanium ultra-high molecular weight liner to withstand years of wear and tear."

The shaftless screw is the only moving part in the system, an intentional design in efforts to keep things simple and requiring little maintenance. Front and rear spray bars with 1 gpm nozzles keep the unit clean and free of buildup. The lower cover of the unit also contains two built-in 1 gpm nozzles for cleaner trash. Lever hold-downs allow for easy removal of the covers to access the U-channel and shaftless screw conveyor.

To achieve variable speeds, ScreencO uses a 3 hp Nord gear reduction drive with a Lenze variable frequency drive control, providing users with a range of 6 to 28 rpms. The drive is powered by a 220-volt single phase plug-and-play system.
